DATES: Sunday July 12 through Thursday, July 16, 2009
Day campers will begin on Monday
Overnight campers will arrive at 5:00 pm (**no earlier please**) Sunday

PLACE: Camp Kinard, Leesville, South Carolina

WHO: **Day campers** – rising first and second graders will leave from church at 8:30am and arrive back by 5:15pm, Monday through Wednesday. On Thursday, they will remain at camp for supper and the closing program and return home with parents.

Overnight campers – rising third graders through tenth graders.

COST: **Day Camp - \$135 - Overnight Camp - \$215 - Limited scholarship assistance is available.**
For a confidential request, speak to Pastor Paul.
Non-member friends of Ebenezer are welcome if they commit to the entire camp experience, including the closing program. **Checks should be made payable to “Ebenezer” and designated “Music Camp”**

NOTE: REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT DEADLINE IS JULY 5, 2009.

The cost includes all camp facilities, T-shirt, all supplies, breakfast, lunch, and supper each day for overnight campers; lunch each day and supper on Thursday for day campers. Volunteers will bring snacks and beverages each day.

PROGRAM: The daily program will include singing, use of tone chimes and Orff instruments, crafts, puppets and scenery preparation for youth, Bible study, leadership training for youth, and group building, swimming and recreation.

CLOSING

PROGRAM: On Thursday evening, the congregation, guests, and family members are invited to a picnic, a display of crafts and other activities done at Music Camp, and the closing program. The closing program will be the performance of the original musical, **Noah**.

WHAT TO BRING TO

CAMP: **Overnight campers** – sleeping bag or sheets, pillow, flashlight with new batteries, washcloth, soap, personal toiletries, comfortable clothing, extra pair of shoes, towels, swimsuit, sunscreen. Mark items with child's name for easy identification.

Day campers - two twin sheets for use on beds during rest time, books for rest time, towel, swimsuit, and sunscreen. Mark items with child's name for easy identification.

Two weeks after camp, any unclaimed items will be donated to The Cooperative Ministry.

MEDICATIONS – All medications to be taken by a registrant must be checked with the camp nurse upon arrival (Please include written instructions for dispensing medication and place in a zip lock bag labeled with the child's name).

DO NOT BRING TO CAMP! – Cell phone, electronics such as Tape/CD players, computer games, or other valuables that might be lost. Please do not send any cash. Everything will be provided. Smoking, possession of alcohol or illegal substances will not be permitted.
